Evangelizing and Discipling Women

Course objectives:

The student will investigate biblical models of evangelism and discipleship for women in today's world and will practice and grow in her own evangelistic conversations and discipling relationships.

Course requirements:

A. Pre-session requirements

1. The student will read chapters 1 – 4 of the text, *Reimagining evangelism*.

1. The student will read chapters 5 – 8 and the appendices 1 – 4 of the text, *Reimagining evangelism*.
2. The student will write a "verbatim" report of an evangelistic conversation and an outline of her discipleship resources and plan.
