Authorization for Lay Delegate

For example, if the voting membership of an accredited church is between 150 and 249, the church may send one additional lay delegate; if the voting membership is between 250 and 349, the church may send two additional lay delegates. The church shall appoint and certify lay delegates as specified in the local church bylaws (*2007 Manual, p. A2-6, Section 6.2, A(3)*).
